Impact at different levels


Institutional level/members of the alliance:

- ➤ To what extend did the alliance achieve the goals as set out in its strategic plan/proposal?
- What are the reasons for not achieving certain goals?

Policy level:

- European level: did the initiative achieve its goals?
- National/system level: to what extent is the initiative a catalyst for system reforms that benefit the whole sector?



Expected benefits from participating in the European Universities Initiative




EUA Survey Q88: What are/might be the benefits that you expect for your higher education institution from participating in the initiative?

Challenges in participating in the European Universities Initiative




EUA Survey Q89: What are/would be the challenges for your institution in participating in the initiative? Please rate the degree of the challenges listed below. - Language issues N=190

Key considerations for impact assessment

- Different levels of impact need to be distinguished.
- Alliances should be assessed against their own strategic goals.
- External barriers need to be taken into account in the assessment.
- ➤ The instrument should be assessed against its fitness for purpose.
- ➤ Time matters: many of the goals and expectations are long-term, so focus now needs to be on progress made.
- ➤ If the initiative is supposed to work as catalyst for system level reforms, quick fix exceptions will not be enaugh!
