Website access

RATIONALE:

Students want to meet peers, want to learn from peers with different educational background, want to feel supported by their equals in their efforts to cope and become resilient to a good health and well-being.

All seven partner universities have developed buddy, tutor or mentoring services for students, including those being on a study or placement mobility. In all seven partner universities there is an incredibly supportive service from academic and administrative staff.

A very new integrated peer counselling service is needed. A pilot service has started at one of the partner universities – Alexandru Ioan Cuza University of Iasi (UAIC) – as a response to the recent challenges that mobility students had to cope with during the last year. Additionally, a virtual room for peer support group is under preparation for the fall semester, 2021. Both services are innovative and a patents filing is under consideration.

OBJECTIVES:

The online GLADE Counselling lab for students of all ages brings together all support services additionally developed by the International relations offices for students during their mobility - incoming and outgoing - and existing counselling services for students in the EC2U partners' universities, with the very new peer counselling support.

AUDIENCE:

The online GLADE Counselling lab for students of all ages will be addressed mainly to students during their international mobility in the EC2U universities for a continuously improving approach of their good health and well-being.



















DEVELOPPED TOOLS/ACTIONS:

• Students requests:

The responses to students' requests will be treated according to the following process:

- For the peer buddy, tutor, mentor, for the academic and administrative support, the responses will be formulated according to the existing and future peer learned practices in each partner university.
- For the online peer individual and group support, the management of requests and responses will be assured by a member of the board of The Virtual Institute for Good Health and Wellbeing (GLADE), who is also a permanent staff of the International Relations Service of UAIC. The online peer individual and group support will be provided by volunteers, master and doctoral students with a psycho-social academic background having appropriate supervision from a professor coordinator, member of EC2U team from the Alexandru Ioan Cuza University of Iasi.

The involved students providing support will sign a contract as volunteers in the International Relations Office of UAIC.

• Convention Form and Management of Personal data

Students involved in the online peer individual and group support – both the beneficiaries and the providers - will express their agreement to proceed by signing a predefined convention form, validated by the Dean of the Faculty of Psychology and Educational Science from UAIC. This process will be managed electronically, in 1-3 days upon receipt of the request for online peer counselling support. The convention form is provided in Annex 2. The consent for personal data processing is included. The individual service will be available in English and Romanian. The group support service will be available from October, 2021.

The personal data filled in the form will be processed, stored and shared by the personnel of the seven EC2U universities, during the application process and throughout the duration of the student mobility, in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) and Law no. 190/2018 on measures to implement (EU) Regulation 2016/679 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation). By filling and signing this form, the students - the beneficiary and the provider – give their consent to the processing and storage of personal data by the employees of the institution and the sharing of personal data to other state authorities, respectively.

• Other planned activities:

- First staff training event: 26/04/2021, 10h-12h CET (online)

The WP4 board will organise a Staff training event to share best practices among the EC2U universities in assisting and supporting students during their mobility.



















- Special students' event during second EC2U week: 19/05/2021, 14h-16h CET (online)

The WP4 board will invite the most active students' associations from each EC2U university to present, for 15 minutes, their best practices in supporting the international students during their mobility. Registered students will have the opportunity to raise questions and discuss with their peers.

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ANNEX 2: GLADE Online Counselling LAB - CONVENTION for individual peer counselling

CONVENTION

Regarding the provision of on-line peer psycho-social support provided by students of the Clinical Psychology and Psychotherapy (CPP) master programme, together with their mentors, clinical psychologists, occasioned by the international mobility experiences and / or isolation measures imposed by the epidemic context, starting with the second semester of the academic year 2020-2021.

I. The provider of the psycho-social support:

The providers of the psycho-social support will be students of the Clinical Psychology and Psychotherapy (CPP) master programme, Faculty of Psychology and Education Sciences, Alexandru Ioan Cuza University of Iași, under the frame of the activities of the "Clinical Internship" course, supervised by their course holders and mentoring psychologists, following the proposition made in the frame of the EC2U project.

II. The beneficiary of the psycho-social support:

III. Rights and obligations of the two parties:

- 1. The beneficiary agrees to communicate by phone and in writing (email, whatsapp, messenger, etc.) with the CPP student, who will be appointed by the professor coordinator from the Faculty of Psychology and Education Sciences.
- 2. The beneficiary understands and agrees that the communication sessions which will take place will have the role of specialised practice so as the CPP student develop the relevant professional skills for clinical psychology and psychotherapy.
- 3. The beneficiary may at any time cease the collaboration with the CPP student in case of impediments such as lack of time or dissatisfaction with the received support.
- 4. The beneficiary is willing to answer the CPP student's questions (in oral or in writing), but has the right to refuse for own reasons, without being forced to offer explanations.
- 5. The CPP student (provider) strictly abides by the confidentiality rules and does not disclose in any context the family name or first name of the interlocutor in the communication sessions when providing the peer psycho-social support.
- 6. The CPP student (provider) will ask the coordinator professor for informational support during the process of counselling and supervision, in case of possible difficulties encountered.
- 7. The CPP student (provider) will carry out research regularly and will direct the supportive communication with the beneficiary to the relevant subjects in the context of mobility and / or isolation imposed by the epidemiologic risk:















- Adherence to the recommendations which aim to reduce the spread of the infection with COVID-19 (hand hygiene, as little exposure outdoors as possible, etc.),
- Maintain a rational way of thinking, without catastrophizing but remain receptive to the information on the evolution of the pandemic made public only by the official sources,
- Understand the new frames of the activity as education opportunities by using the time once allocated to moving from one place to another for study,
- Efficient time management by planning activities and outcomes with deadlines,
- Increase social skills through the communication with the beloved ones from a distance, and properly understand the importance of the provided and received support,
- Learn at least one relaxing technique to deal with stress.
- 8. The beneficiary will ask for specialised support in case of suffering and/or symptoms which might go beyond the CPP student's competencies and will not hold the CPP student responsible for any symptom that might occur during the supportive communication sessions.
