<u>Name</u>: Pedagolab, Tutothèque, MOTIVE, Pédago'Num

Short description: The four names mentioned above are the pedagogical platforms (tutorial/self-learning platforms) at the University of Poitiers. The Pedagolab (resources for teachers) and Tutothèque (resources for students) are open to all. These 4 platforms offer PDF, video tutorials and webinars on teaching, learning and digital uses. For example, on the 18th of March 2022 a "café pedago" was organised, on the scripting of a distance learning course.

Short description: Every year, since the start of the 2019/2020 academic year, the University Libraries service is invited to the doctoral student welcome days to present, in two hours, Open Science and its issues. In 2022, it took place as a part of the "Research Ethics and Scientific Integrity" awareness days on February 1 and 2, 2022. The points covered are: Open Science, actors and issues; the academic publishing market; Research data, good practices in terms of data collection; the French National Plan for Open Science and the digital identity of researchers (PIDs).

On this occasion, the "Passport for Open Science", published by the Ministry of Higher Education and Research, is presented and distributed to participants. This awareness is coupled with training provided during the year by the University Libraries service to doctoral students of all disciplines: "The digital identity of the researcher and the permanent identifiers", "the market for academic publication in the humanities and social sciences", "copyright and distribution licenses" etc...

Name: Training and information actions around the HAL open archive portal "University of Poitiers"

Short description: In 2017, the University of Poitiers adopted an institutional open archive portal: "HAL Université de Poitiers". Each year, the university library service, which administers this portal, opens new collections for laboratories, presents the portal to researchers and doctoral students, and organizes training and information sessions about open access and open science. For example, in 2021, seven new HAL collections have been opened and 45 people (researchers and PhD students) have been trained in its use and in the challenges of open science through different training schemes (individual, group, face-to-face, distance, etc.).

# II. Preparatory work for the upcoming EC2U internal campaigns

# A. Brief description – duplicating local actions at the level of the Alliance

The mapping of Partner universities' Open Science and Open Education provides key insights into the actions led locally. The diverse activities listed above clearly shows the potential of the different members to pool resources to create future campaigns adapted and adaptable to the EC2U Campus.

The overarching goal of the EC2U internal awareness campaigns will be to raise public interest and educate the EC2U Community about defined topics, missions, visions etc. in Open Education and Open Science. An advantage of awareness campaigns is the flexibility of methods that can include a variety of tactics to reach and engage the targeted audience. EC2U will adopt a coherent strategy linked to the existing programmes of the seven Partner universities. The mapping above allowed the EC2U Alliance to identify which activities are led across the EC2U Campus, by the seven Partner universities. This collegial approach increases the Coordination team's understanding of the resources in place/needed and the impact of these programmes on local communities.

As these programmes, and corresponding resources, exist at the Partner universities, the EC2U Coordination team believes it was relevant to duplicate existing programmes to the level of the Alliance, building upon existing skillsets and expertise of each university. Duplicating these actions and constructing them via a collegial approach will ensure a shared culture of openness across the Alliance via Open Education and Open Science awareness campaigns.

Though this deliverable does not detail the proposed programme (which will be shared in the deliverable D8.14), this document serves the purpose of enumerating the global direction of this activity and the implementation processes of the EC2U internal campaigns for Open Science and Open Education.
