

The EC2U Joint Master's Programme "European Languages, Cultures and Societies in Contact" is a **2-year Master's Degree** (4 semesters, 30 ECTS each, 120 ECTS in total) that provides students with an in-depth **knowledge of the European linguistic, cultural and social landscape** using advanced research methods in the academic field. This degree is in line with professional practice and will ensure students to launch their career with **enhanced professionalism and quality of services in the broad field of language, cultural contact and social diversity.**

A new university to discover each semester!

The EC2U Campus provides students with the opportunity to study abroad, gain multicultural experiences, and expand their professional network. Over the course of their learning journey, students can study in up to 4 of the 8 EC2U universities.

A degree tailored to students' needs

- > University of Turku (Finland)


These universities provide students with personalised attention throughout their studies and a unique campus and student life.

Two semesters abroad are required and students may not spend more than 2 semesters at the same university.



Admission requirements

- a. Candidates must hold a Bachelor's
 Degree (or recognised equivalent)
 in one of the following areas:
 Modern Languages, Philology,
 Culture, History, International
 Relations, and other Social Sciences
 and Humanities (SSH);
- b. Candidates must know at least two languages at B2 level (according to the Common European Framework) among the following: Italian, Spanish, Portuguese, French besides English (B2) as a lingua franca.









^{**}The fourth semester is reserved for thesis preparation, related learning and research activities. An Erasmus mobility programme to any of the universities of the EC2U Alliance is also possible during the final semester.
