An objective of the EC2U Alliance is to **actively contribute to developing Sustainable Cities and Communities**. In line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Plan, EC2U implements cross-cutting activities to challenge society to re-think sustainability.

- **The 2025 Student Challenge**

Redesigning the Coimbra’s transport network... Imagining new mobile applications to foster sustainable mobility... Over 112 EC2U Students during the 2025 EC2U Forum, came together and presented innovative ideas for the EC2U Alliance to build upon.

- **A new Sustainable Campus Network**

The EC2U Sustainable Campus Network was launched in 2025, fostering deeper collaboration among universities and municipalities. This new network is currently contributing to the implementation of Climate Change Action Plans within the framework of the Covenant of Mayors.

- **EC2U Think Tank’s Policy Recommendations on Building resilience to climate change**

EC2U Think Tanks bring together a wide-range of stakeholders across Europe around common topics. The 2025 Think Tank, focused on sustainability, put forth the importance of science, education and community initiatives in building climate resilience.

Entrepreneurial Week

In 2024, EC2U organised an **Entrepreneurial Week on “Health Innovation”** which continues to demonstrate its lasting impact on students from various academic and professional backgrounds. In 2025, participants were contacted to **further understand how entrepreneurial formats can unlock potential** in ways that are both individual and impactful.

How has EC2U impacted you?

Sven Padutsch, who completed his Master's in Physics at FSU Jena, gained valuable momentum through the EC2U experience. What began as a curiosity turned into a concrete entrepreneurial pursuit. Sven is currently developing a 3D printing business focused on customized mechanical components. He has already written a full business plan and, as of June 17, 2025, was awarded a startup prize from ThEx Enterprise, a startup support service in Thuringia, Germany.

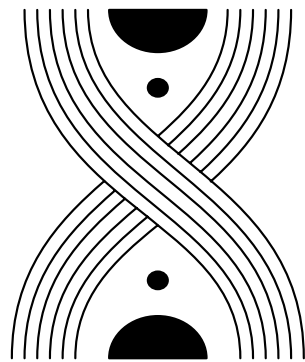

How has EC2U impacted you?

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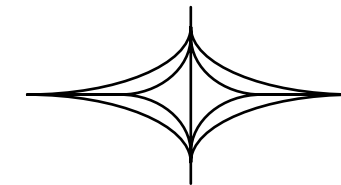

A strong-point of the EC2U Alliance is its capacity to build upon community feedback, evaluate and learn from activities, and adopt a forward-looking perspective. A key tool to do so is the yearly **EC2U Higher Education Round Table** which gathers internal and external experts to discuss hot topics. In 2025, the Higher Education Round Table was the opportunity to bring to the table the newly developed European Commission's programme "Union of Skills".

In a nutshell, the **EC2U Alliance has a key role to play in high-quality skill development, and concrete outcomes and potential impacts have already been demonstrated in core areas of action** including entrepreneurial and challenge-based activities as well as lifelong learning initiatives. 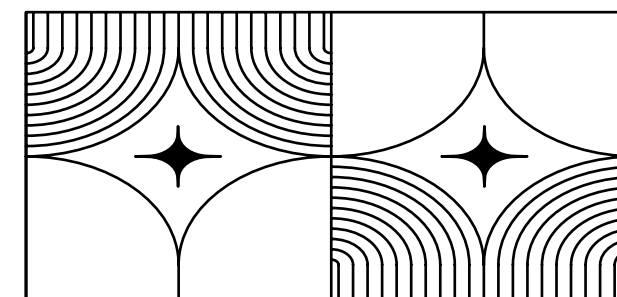
Conclusions
